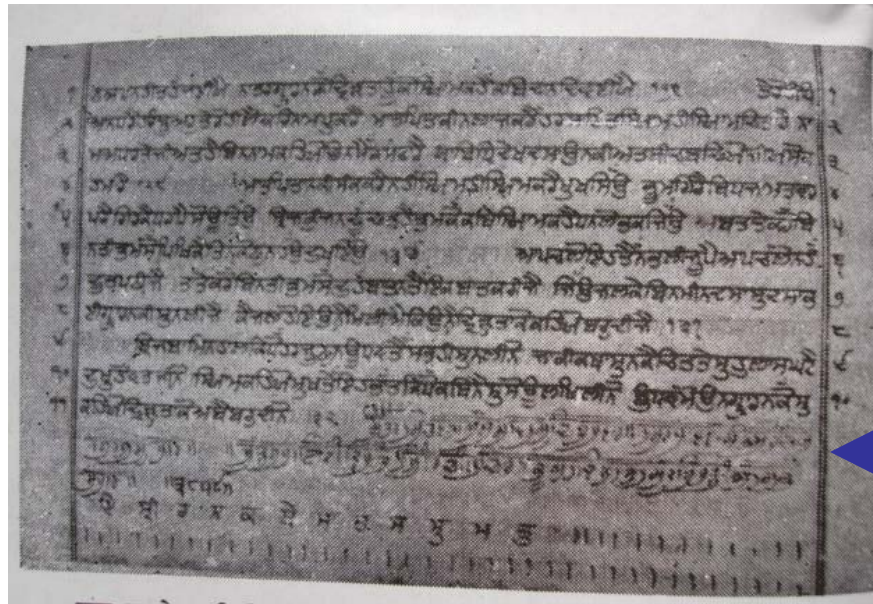
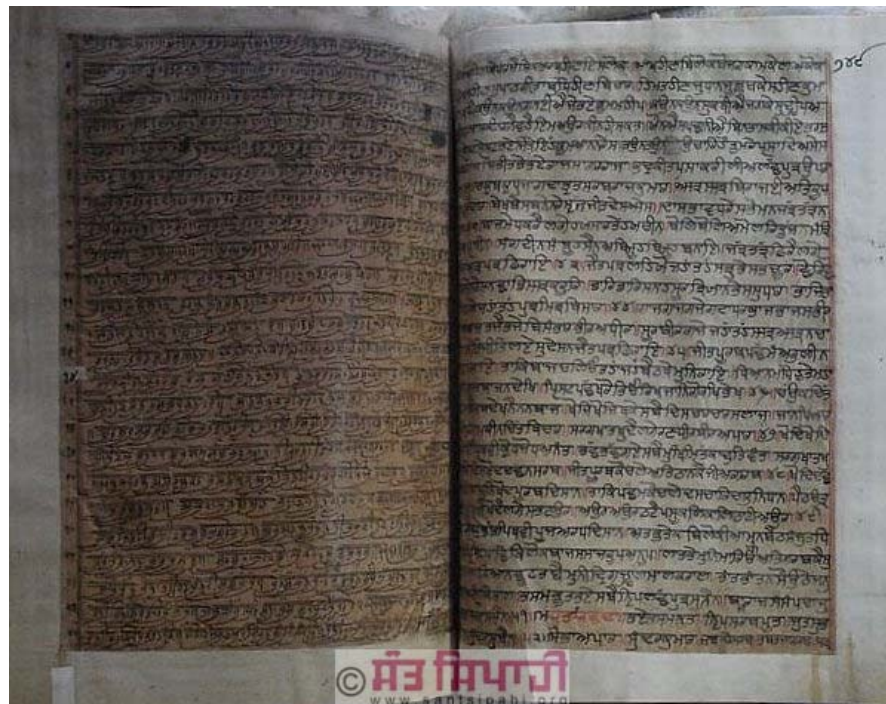


# GURBANI WRITTEN IN GURU GOBIND SINGH SAHIB'S OWN HAND

*Khas-patra* in Anandpuri *Beerh* of Sri Dasam Granth (Correction in Guru Gobind Singh Sahib's own handwriting)



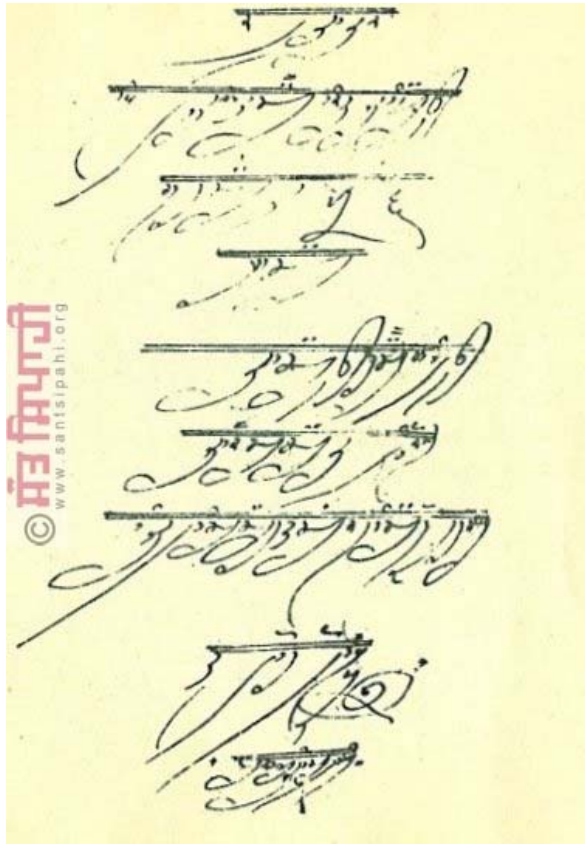
'Khas Patra' (important page) from 'Bhai Mani Singh Beerh'

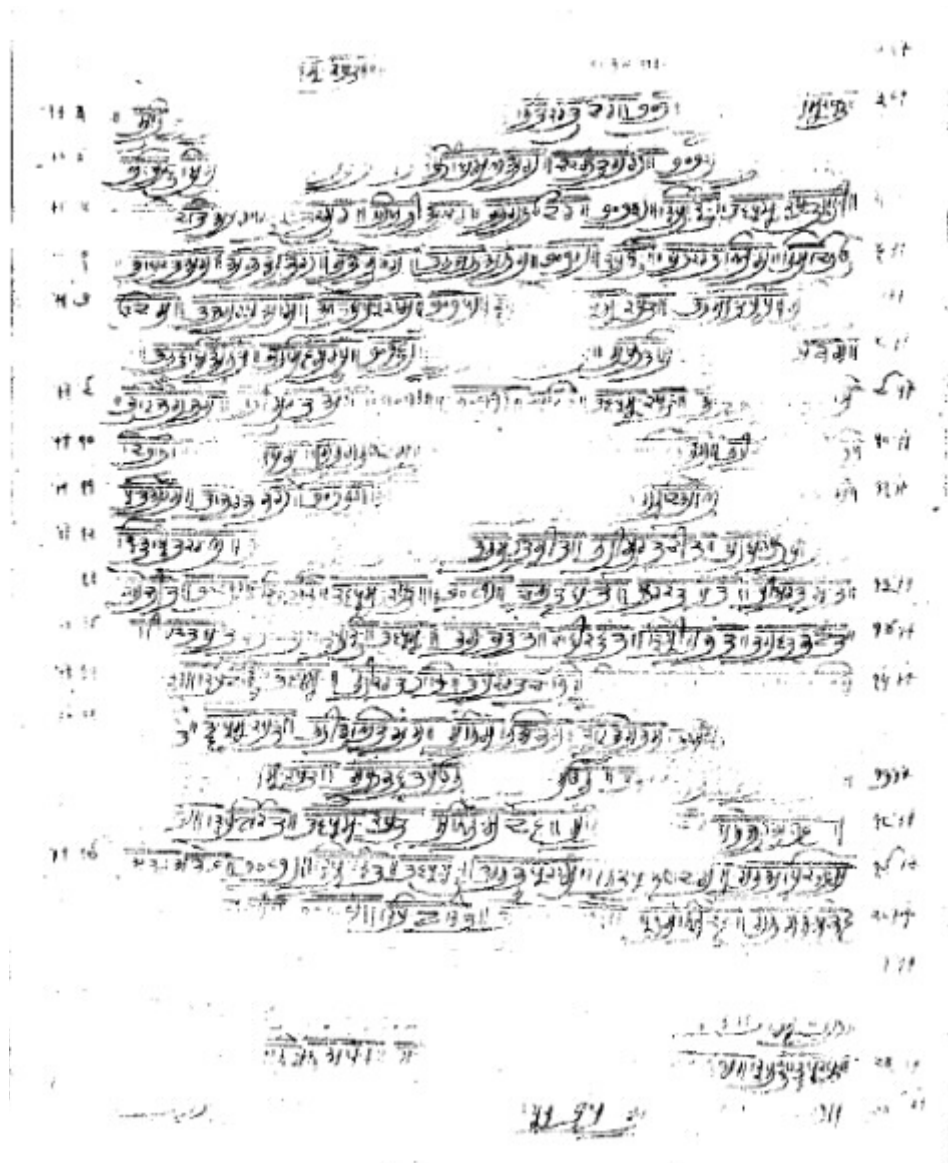

 (Mark the unique style of hand drawings of swords and arrows that make up the border)

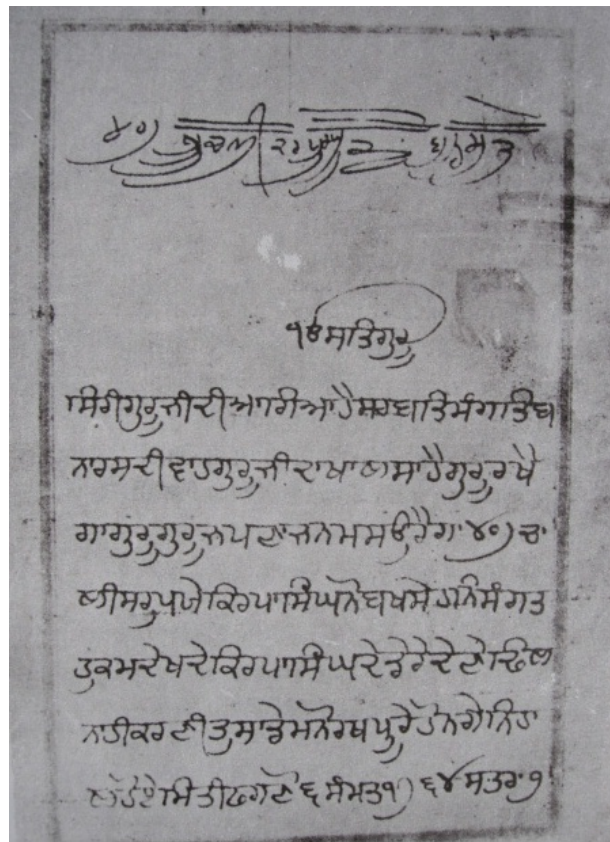

Signatures of Guru Gobind Singh Sahib on the Hukumnama to Bhai Triloka and Bhai Rama from the family of Phul - also known as the Patiala Hukumnama - includes the line 'Tera ghar mera assey' - later used as the 'Motto' on the crest of the Patiala Maharajas (2 August 1696)
